

REFRACTION POLICY

One of the most important parts of your eye exam is the refraction. A refraction is a measurement of the lens power necessary to prescribe glasses or other corrective lenses. It is NOT a covered service by Medicare and many other insurance plans. The refraction fee is collected at the time of service. This is in addition to any co-payment, co-insurance, or deductible your plan may require. Should your plan pay us for the refraction, we will reimburse you.

I have read the above information and understand that the refraction is a non covered service I accept full responsibility for the cost of this service and understand it is due at the time of service. I understand that any co-pay, co-insurance, or deductible I may have is separate from and not included in the refraction fee.
